Milwaukee County Residents *ARE YOU AT RISK?*

- Devastating floods occur in U.S. every year causing more than \$2 billion in damage.
- You have a 26% chance of experiencing a flood during the life of a 30-year mortgage compared to a 9% chance of a fire.
- Floods and flash floods occur in all 50 states.
- Losses due to flooding are not covered under most homeowners' or business policies.

Understand your risk. Mapped floodplains are being revised for Lake Michigan and various streams within the Milwaukee River Watershed. By attending this important Flood Map Information Open House, you will have the opportunity to locate your home on preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) and obtain valuable information on flood insurance coverage offered through the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). On hand will be representatives from FEMA, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and your local community who will address any questions you may have and provide you with **ways you can protect your home and loved ones from future flooding**.
